CBAM compliance in the transitional period (1/10/2023 - 31/12/2025)

EU CBAM impacts **various** commodities imported in the EU, covering iron, steel and aluminium goods, cement, fertilisers, electricity and hydrogen (+700 different CN codes). During the transitional period (1 October 2023 to 31 December 2025), companies need to report on the carbon emissions linked to the imported products in scope. Compliance with these reporting requirements remains a big challenge for many EU importers and non-EU manufacturers.
